Mayor Don Tatzin, in his State of the City speech at the Businessperson of the Year dinner on January 30, recalled when he was a first time mayor back in 1987. He noted that Lafayette has changed dramatically since then for the better, especially when compared to the county, the state and the federal government. - Finish and open the Library
- Adopt the downtown Strategic Plan
- Fix more failed roads and reduce the backlog
- Implement the Financial Review Committee's recommendations
- Decide on continuing with the County Sheriff for police services or take another path
 - Look for opportunities to acquire sites in good locations for public parking
 - Provide a local stimulus package to help our businesses
