Teen versus tree, 7/13/10 Neither was a winner. Around 12:30 in the morning Moraga officers responded to a report of a vehicle that had crashed into a tree at Corliss and Camino Ricardo. Officers noted it appeared that the driver was attempting to flee the scene. An intoxicated juvenile at the intersection let an "unknown person" drive his car - who then crashed into the tree and ran. Thankfully only property damage occurred. There were no witnesses.
