Another project liked by the council is the construction of a living landscape berm in

the Theatre District to provide visual and sound separation from Highway 24. Staff noted that several long-term projects had been eliminated as financially infeasible, including an aerial gondola, tunneling behind the existing support structures for the highway, or widening the overpass supports, all of which would definitely require a

corridor study. While Mayor Inga Miller agreed, she also pointed out that the city really needs to be looking at a complete fix, down the road, far out in the future. However, they need to be looking at how to maintain pedestrian safety and enhance bicycle safety in the meantime.


