irror Mirror on the wall, what's the worst movie of the year thus far? How does Hollywood take a beloved classic story and proceed to destroy it? It breaks the one rule of filmmaking: shooting a bad script. There were a few clever twists to the magic mirror, the poison apple, and the kiss, but that did not help. The film could not decide if it was a slapstick comedy or a straight comedy. The acting was all over the place. Julia Roberts, the Evil Queen, who has not had a good performance since Erin Brockovich, which was not Oscar-worthy in my opinion, has hit rock bottom.
