They collected over 875 pounds of clothing and shoes filling 25 large boxes with much needed supplies. On Saturday, Oct. 11, all of the boxes were delivered to Trust in Education in Lafayette where they will be loaded onto pallets and transported to Travis Air Force Base for delivery to Afghanistan.
