ROTATE crops. Don't plant vegetables in the same

BUY summer annuals for containers to add color to

PINCH petunias and dahlias to keep them blooming. **RAISE** the blades on lawnmowers to offer more sun protection and moisture retention to your grass.

PROVIDE abodes for toads by placing broken clay pots throughout the garden. By inviting toads into your garden, you'll be getting free insect control.

RESCUE thirsty bees and ladybugs that dive into your swimming pool during the heat. Use a net to capture and release to avoid unnecessary stings.

HELP reverse the decline of pollinating insects, honey bees, native bees, birds, bats and monarch butterflies by joining the Million Pollinator Garden Challenge.
